

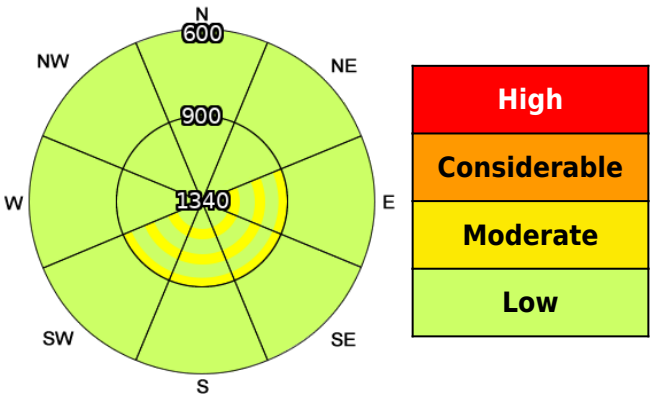

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 01/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the night areas of fresh windslab will be deposited on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. These are not expected to be extensive, and in general should be avoidable. Where scoured by the wind the existing snowpack will be very hard and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some overnight snow showers a dry day is expected. The freezing level will drop to around 300 metres through the night. Moderate North-Westerly winds veer to the North and ease slightly.
