

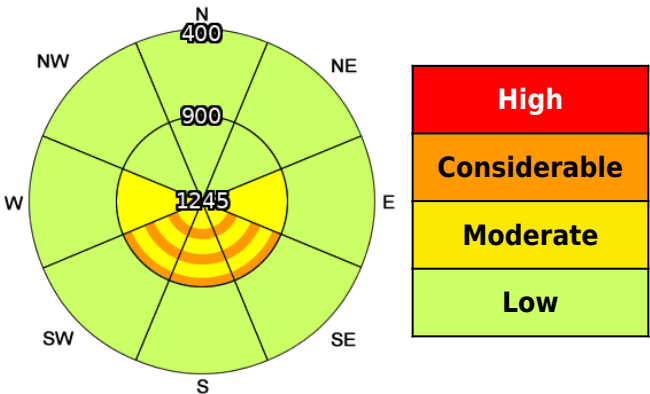

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 02/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will generally be well bonded and stable on all aspects and levels and will continue to re-freeze. However some fresh accumulations will form unstable windslab on mainly South West to South-East aspects above 900 metres around corrie rims, gully exits and sheltered hollows. Localised deposits will form on other aspects due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong Northerly with light snow showers overnight and during the day. Overnight it will be freezing at all levels and during the day the freezing level will be at 200 metres.

Comments

Refrozen snowpack is solid and ice glazed with serious runouts. Some 'russian roulette' breakable crust which makes walking difficult - but this is improving in the colder temperatures.
