

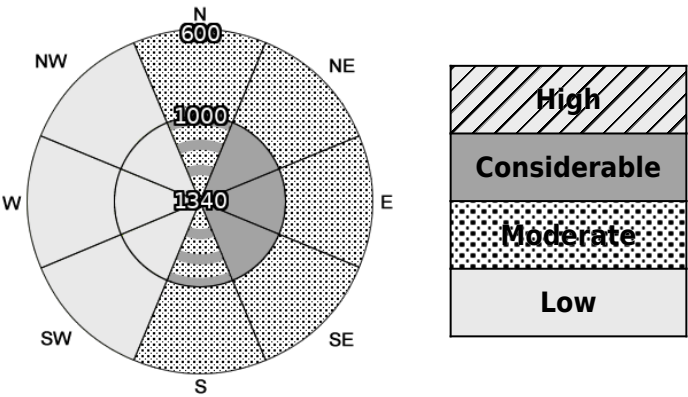

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 03/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow stability is expected to deteriorate through the day as poorly bonded windslab is deposited on North-East to South-East aspects, and in other sheltered locations, above 1000 meters. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. Where scoured by the wind, the snowpack will remain firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a few snow showers overnight and during the morning, snow will become more persistent through the afternoon and turn to rain at lower levels. Northerly winds will back to the West and strengthen. The freezing level will rise to around 1000 metres.

Comments

Fresh snowfall expected intermittently through the coming week.
