



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Pockets of new poorly-stabilised windslab will continue to accumulate, gain depth and become more widespread on most North to East to South-East aspects above 850m, there will be some cross loading onto steep gully flanks and around coire rims. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will remain around summits with further snow showers overnight and during the day. Winds will be moderate West becoming South Westerly.
