

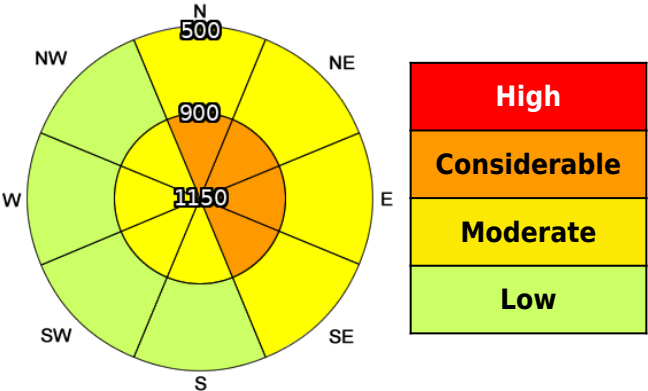

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Soft, poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on top of the already significant accumulations found on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. These deposits will show poor stability, particularly where they are sitting on top the very firm, older snowpack and avalanches are likely in these locations. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some overnight snow showers, more persistent snow will fall through the day. Moderate Westerly winds will back to the South-West. The freezing level is expected to be around 1000 metres.

Comments

Snow and strong winds made for some quite wild conditions on the summits today.
