

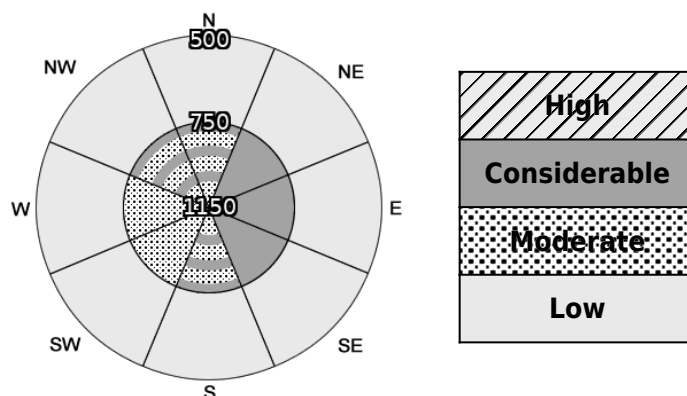

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wind slab will continue to form on North through to South-Easterly aspects. This additional loading will be significant above 750 meters where there are already localised weakly bonded layers on steep convex slopes. The rise in freezing level will de-stabilise the snow pack further. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be further snow showers overnight with heavier snow showers tomorrow. Winds will be Westerly to South-Westerly with the freezing level rising to above 1000 metres.

Comments

Very icy on low angle terrain too. Older deeper snowpack generally strong with areas of concern mainly the top of gullies.
