


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 05/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present, and further accumulations will be deposited, in sheltered gullies, hollows and slopes. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South aspects above 700 metres where avalanches are likely. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected overnight and then more persistent snowfall above about 300 metres during the day. The winds are expected to be strong South-Westerly overnight veering North-Westerly. The freezing level will be around 450 metres during the day.

Comments

Freezing level is expected to drop overnight and during Wednesday.
