

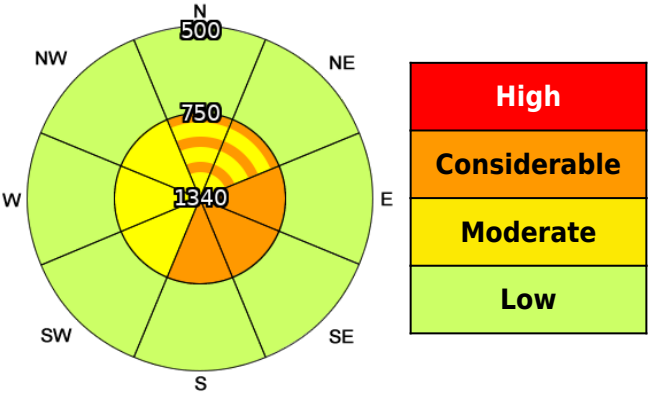

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The increasing NW winds will redistribute the existing unconsolidated snow as unstable windslab. Greatest accumulations will be on steep East, South-East and South aspects above 900m. Localised areas of unstable snow will also be present on steep North and North-East aspects. Avalanches are likely in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue on Thursday with an increasing North-Westerly wind.
