



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 06/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant drifting will occur in the strong winds and unstable accumulations of windslab will form on mainly North-East through South to South-Westerly aspects above 700 metres where avalanches are likely. Localised deposits of unstable snow will form on other aspects due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight winds will be strong North-Westerly which will strengthen further in the day. Snow showers will become more frequent. Freezing at all levels.

Comments

Good hard snow interspersed with soft slab accumulations on most aspects, remaining cold windy with snowfall.
