



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised wind loading will produce isolated areas of weakly bonded wind slab on all aspects from North through East to South above 750 metres where avalanches are likely. The deeper snowpack is generally well bonded and weak layers are not producing easy shears with the existing load. Surface slab instability continues to be a concern. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will back from Westerly to South-West. This will be the significant weather feature with temperatures remaining cold and no precipitation forecast.

Comments

The new surface slab can be released with a ski jump on steep convex terrain.
