



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 08/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change; cold temperatures will persist and the recent deposits of weakly bonded snow will be slow to consolidate on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 800m. Deepest deposits will lie at the top of corrie backwalls and gully heads with additional windslab developing mostly on South- Easterly aspects with any new snow showers towards the end of the day. All cornices will remain weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with occasional or very light snow showers during the day. Winds will back from the North-East to North-West.
