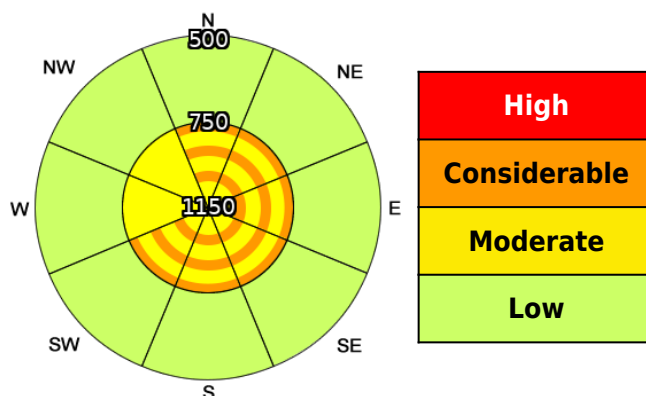


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 08/01/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Isolated areas of weakly bonded slab will persist on North-East through East to South aspects above 750m on steep, convex terrain. New wind slab will build on South-West aspects where avalanches are likely in high steep terrain. The thickness of this new slab will not be great but the bond will be weak due to forming in the continued cold temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Light snow showers are forecast with a change in wind direction to the North-East backing North-West during the day. Temperatures will remain cold.

Comments

Extra caution still required on the exit slopes of some climbs, watch for crossloaded features.
