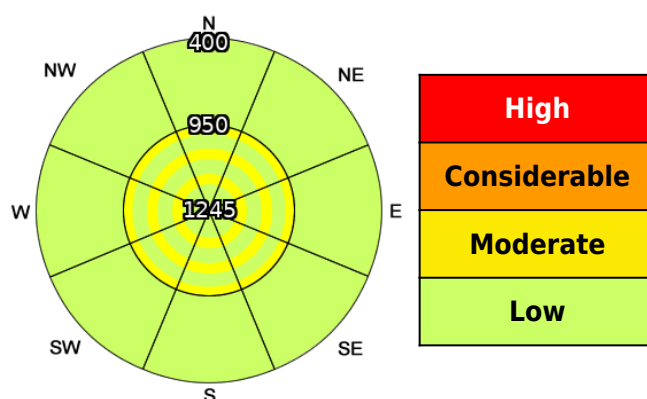


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 09/01/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Further snow accumulations will increase the load on the weakly bonded slab. However the distribution of this slab is mainly on high exit slopes of climbs and very steep convex terrain. Avalanches are likely above 850 metres on North through East to South-West terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Snow showers, some prolonged, are forecast with winds veering from Westerly to North-West. Temperatures will be slightly warmer but below freezing at all elevations.

Comments

Isolated instabilities persist. Mature depth hoar observed in an area of thin snow cover in Caen Lochan glen.
