

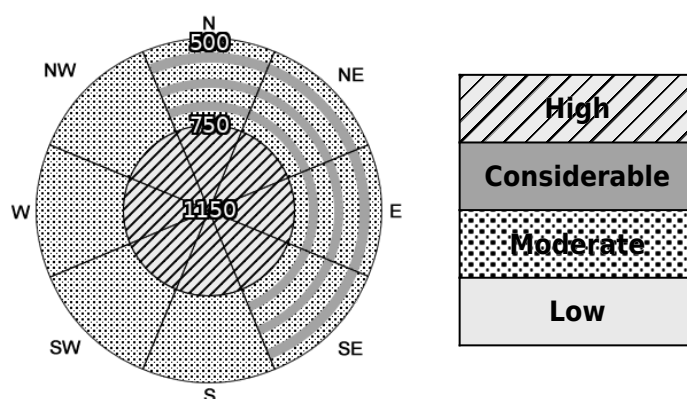

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 10/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Strong winds and further snow on nearly all aspects will create additional load on the weakly bonded wind slab. Deeper instabilities will be a concern. Cornices will develop quickly and prone to collapse. Avalanche will occur above 750 metres, particularly cross loaded gully zones. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow is forecast for tonight and Monday with significant accumulations possible. Winds will be strong from the South-West at first becoming Variable direction later. Temperatures will warm slightly but still remain well below freezing at the tops.

Comments

Moderate terrain outside avalanche run out zones recommended. Good snow cover conditions in select terrain.
