

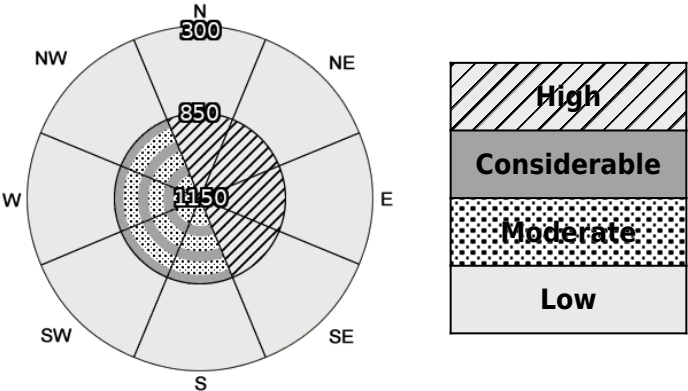

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep accumulations of weakly bonded layered windslab will exist and will continue to develop in all sheltered areas. The greatest deposits will be mainly above 850 metres on North through East to South-East aspects where avalanches will occur. Cross loading and older deposits of instabilities will also be present on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers on very strong South-Westerly winds these will become more variable during the day decreasing in strength. The freezing level will rise to around 300 metres during the day.

Comments

Deep deposits of unstable snow in sheltered locations where caution is required..
