

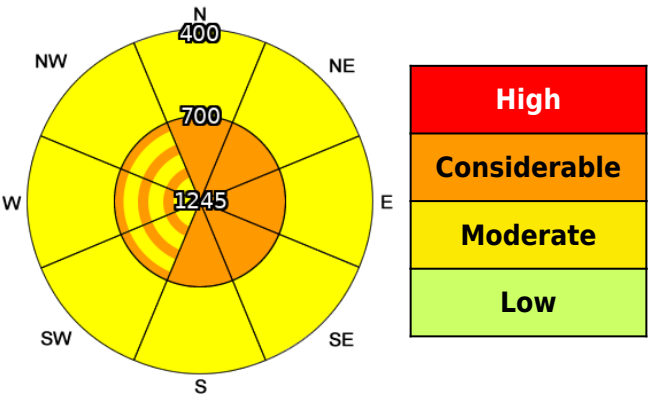

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 11/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow will lie on all aspects. Where underlying weaknesses already exist this will further weaken the snow pack. Avalanches are likely on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres particularly around Coire rims, crag aprons and gully flanks. Localised instabilities will affect remaining aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight there will be moderate snowfall on light North backing North-West winds. During the day it will be dry and light winds will back to the South. The freezing level will fall to 450 metres.

Comments

Variable snowpack with weaknesses on new soft windslab layers and old facet layers.
