

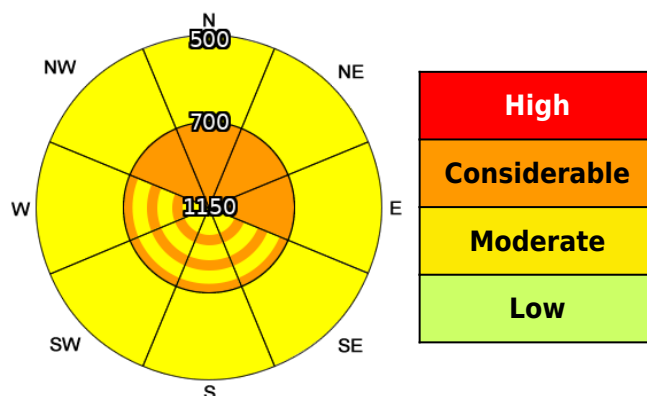

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 13/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The change in temperature will affect stability of the newly formed windslab deposits on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 700 metres. Corrie rims, steep convex rolls and gullies will be unstable. Localised instabilities will affect most other aspects. Cornices will be prone to collapse The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry much of tonight with light Southerly winds. A trough of low pressure will cross the mountain range bringing some rain and sleet in the early morning. The freezing level will rise to above summit levels.

Comments

Warming will lead to instability on all aspects.
