


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 13/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The period of high instability will persist. Avalanches will occur on slopes of many aspects particularly steep gully exits and around coire rims above 900 metres, peak instability will occur with the arrival of any heavy rain early in the day. Recently formed cornices will be fragile and prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

The thaw conditions will continue with further sleet overnight above 1000 metres, this will turn to rain early am dying out by midday, accompanied by Moderate Southerly winds.

Comments

Period of instability persists - awaiting arrival of milder temps and any onset of rain below 1000m.
