

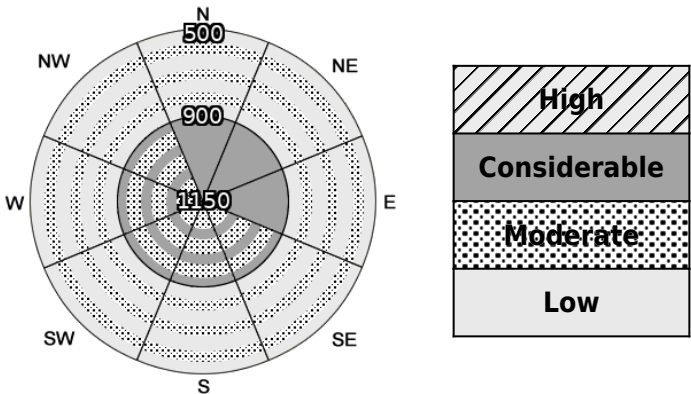

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 14/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight and early in the day wet snow instabilities will exist on steep slopes on all aspects above 900 metres. The existing snowpack will start to consolidate as the freezing level falls; however, snow showers will begin to deposit fresh accumulations of poorly bonded windslab on North to East aspects, and in other sheltered locations above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mild overnight with rain at all levels. Through the day the freezing level will fall to around summit level, and the rain will progressively turn to snow above around 800 metres.

Comments

Rock and ice fall a hazard in the mild and wet conditions.
