

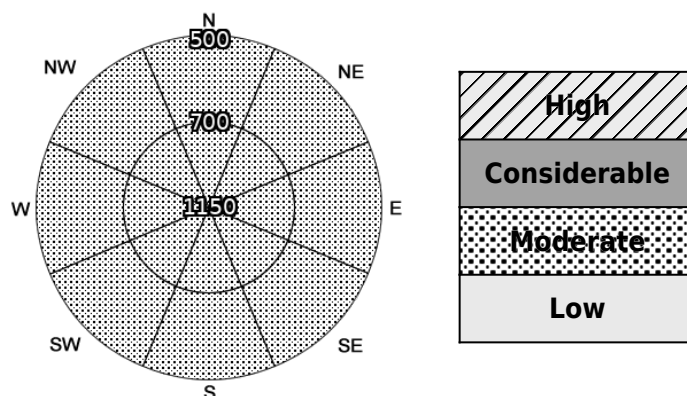

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 14/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the warm part of the forecast period the deeper snowpack will continue to consolidate with some surface loose snow instability on very steep ground. Some small zones of new wind slab will develop on North to North-East aspects above 800 metres due to snow showers later in the period. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

This warmer cycle of weather will continue through most of the forecast period with some cooling later on Friday. Moderate strength winds will be from the South-West backing Southerly. Moderate amounts of rain are forecast with some sleet and snow showers during the cooling.
