


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 16/01/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the freezing level lowers the snowpack will begin to stabilise and consolidate leaving localised instabilities mainly in areas of steep and convex terrain above 950 metres. Small accumulations of windslab will develop in sheltered locations on North to East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy rain will clear overnight. This will be followed by cooler air during the day with isolated snow showers above 900 metres. Winds will be strong and from the South-West.

#### Comments

Very wet and windy conditions in the Cairngorms today.
