



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will begin to consolidate in the colder conditions. However, fresh windslab will be deposited on coire rims and in sheltered locations on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Where scoured by the wind, the snowpack is expected to be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a mild night with further rainfall, it will turn colder through the day. Precipitation will turn progressively to snow above 900 metres. Winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

A very wet day on Saturday, slightly better conditions expected on Sunday.
