



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 16/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The return of cooler conditions will further stabilise a now wet and isothermal snowpack. Some cornice collapse potential remains which has the potential to effect slides from deeper seated residual instabilities within the snowpack. New weakly bonded windslab will develop in steep gully tops and around coire rims with the arrival of any new snow on North to East facing aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further heavy rain is forecast overnight before a return of cooler conditions during the day. This will bring snow showers above 900m accompanied by strong South-Westerly winds.

Comments

Thaw should slow with a return of slightly cooler conditions and FL around summits.
