

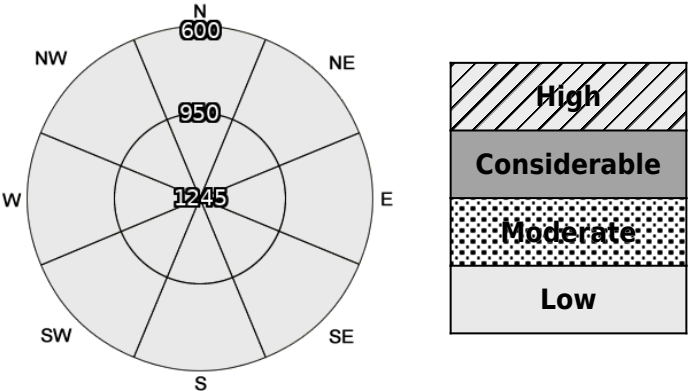

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 17/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will refreeze in the increasingly cold temperatures and will be well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day it will be dry with the strong South-Westerly winds becoming West-South-Westerly and lessening in strength in the daytime. The freezing level will be at 900 metres overnight lowering to 750 metres.

Comments

Colder temperatures expected with -5 degrees C summit temperatures at midday. Re-freezing snowpack
