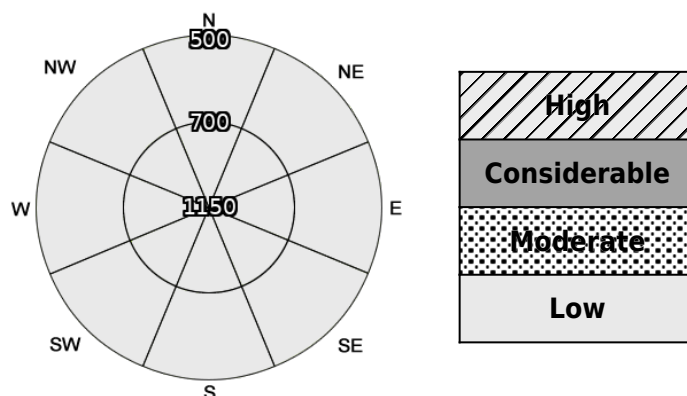


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 17/01/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The cooling temperatures will contribute to a strong melt-freeze snowpack. The previously weak layers appear to have become well bonded in the isothermal snowpack. Surface instabilities will freeze and stabilise at higher elevations on all aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be some cooling and slight easing of winds. The freezing level will be about 750 metres with winds veering from South-West to West-South-West. There is no precipitation forecast.

Comments

Some burns may be bridged by thin, refrozen but weak bridges.
