



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly-stabilised windslab will continue to develop on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 800m where avalanches are likely. All new cornices will be fragile and prone to sudden collapse. Stability will be much better on all aspects directly exposed to the wind. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue overnight and during the day on a moderate to strong West or West-North-West airflow. Freezing level 600 metres.

Comments

Definitely more wintry now. Treacherous breakable crust below 900m on Monday.
