


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 18/01/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack continues to re-freeze and will generally be well bonded and stable on all aspects and at all altitudes. Some isolated pockets of moderately bonded windslab will form in lee areas on mainly North-East to South East aspects above 950 metres, gully flanks, exits and corrie rims being most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will remain dry with moderate Westerly winds. In the day the winds will strengthen slightly and light snow showers are expected. The freezing level will be at 600 metres.

Hard and Icy throughout area. Serious runouts !
