

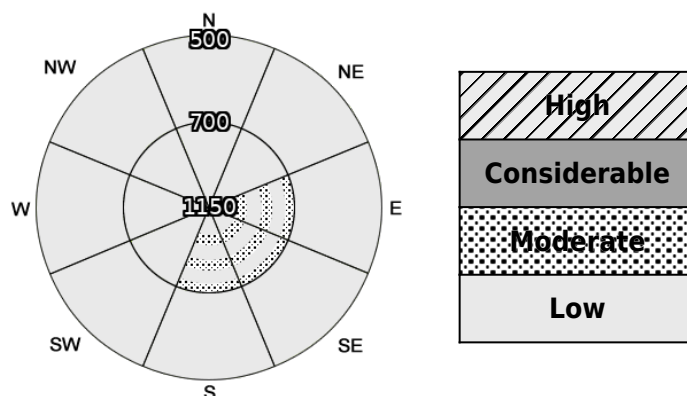

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 18/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow pack will generally consolidate in the cooler temperatures although some isolated pockets of windslab will develop on mainly East through South-East to Southerly aspects above 700 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A showery West to North-Westerly airflow will cover Scotland which will bring occasional or very light snow showers tomorrow. Freezing level 600 metres.

Comments

There are large areas of hard icy snow on higher ground. Exposed rocks are camouflaged with a dusting of new snow!
