

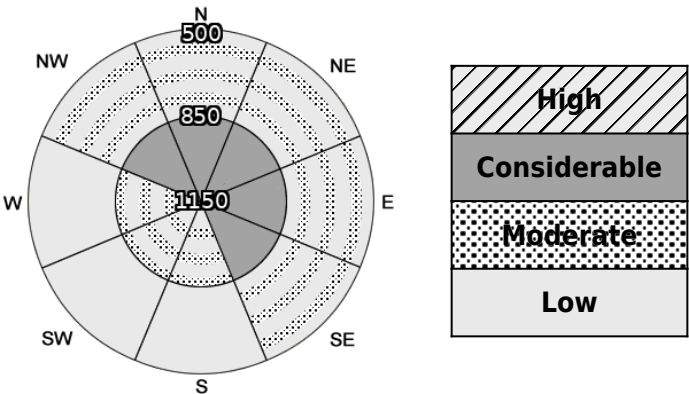

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 18/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to develop in sheltered locations with the greatest deposits being on North-West through to North to South-East aspects. Steep slopes and gullies above 850 metres will be particularly affected and cross loading will take place. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A showery airflow will affect the area giving snow showers through the period. Overnight strong Westerly winds these will become West-North-West during the day, the freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Comments

New snow amounts are not certain and the very strong Westerly winds will re-distribute the snow to lower levels. Wind scoured areas icy.
