


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 19/01/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moderate to strong North-West winds will result in re-distribution of recent accumulations as weakly-stabilised windslab on mostly East to South-East aspects above 800m. There will be some localised cross-loading onto the flanks of steep multi aspect gully exits. All new cornices will remain fragile. Stability will be much better on all aspects directly exposed to the wind. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mostly dry with any snow showers dying out. Winds will be moderate to strong North-Westerly.
