



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 20/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The fluctuating temperatures will help consolidate the snowpack. Pockets of localised instability will persist at highest elevations, especially on multi aspect gully flanks, exits and unsupported pillows of windslab on mainly East to South-East aspects above 950m. New cornices have formed around coire rims, although stability has generally improved. Stability will be good on all aspects directly exposed to the wind. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with freezing all levels overnight, midday summit temperatures of -2 degrees Celsius are forecast. Winds will be moderate Westerly.
