

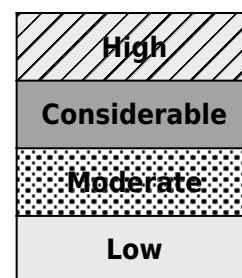

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of windslab will affect mainly coire rims and sheltered locations on Easterly through South to South Westerly aspects above 950 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional light snowfall overnight will die out to leave a dry day. The winds will be moderate North-Westerly with the freezing level just below the summits.
