

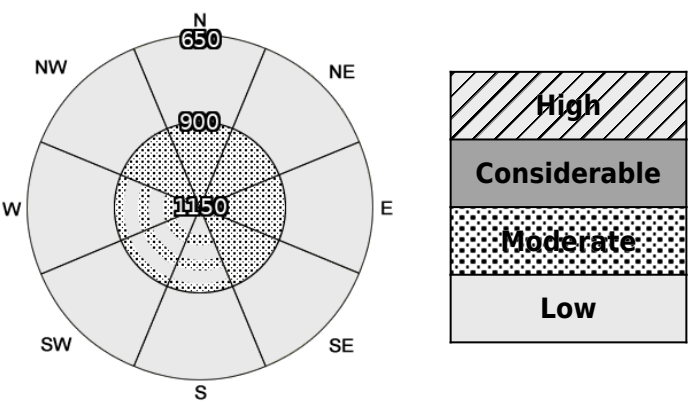

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 23/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 900 metres localised pockets of moderately bonded snow will exist mainly on steeper terrain and scarp slopes with a North-West through North to South-East aspect. Other slope aspects are generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with moderate North-Westerly winds with the freezing level around 1100 metres.

Comments

Although the freezing level is high it should remain cool enough to maintain the present climbing conditions.
