



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 23/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be generally stable. Small isolated pockets of unstable snow will exist, primarily above 850 metres on steep terrain around edges of corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure to the West of Scotland maintains the moderate North-Westerly to Northerly winds. There will be overnight frost in the valleys. Daytime temperatures will be close to freezing on the summits. There will be no precipitation.

Comments

New surface hoar formation will need tracking. At present it has made the skiing better than previous days.
