

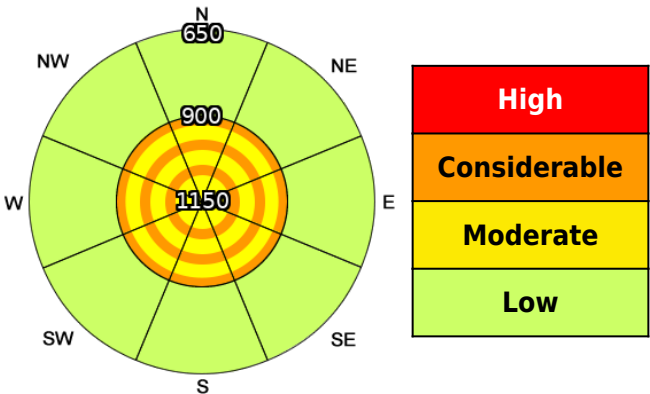

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will exist in sheltered summit gullies and on steep slopes with a North-West through North to South-Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will become strong overnight from a West-North-Westerly direction. Precipitation will be light overnight becoming moderate in the day, falling as sleet or wet snow on the higher slopes mainly above 900 metres.

Comments

Higher ridges and buttresses will be the best option but could be quite windy.
