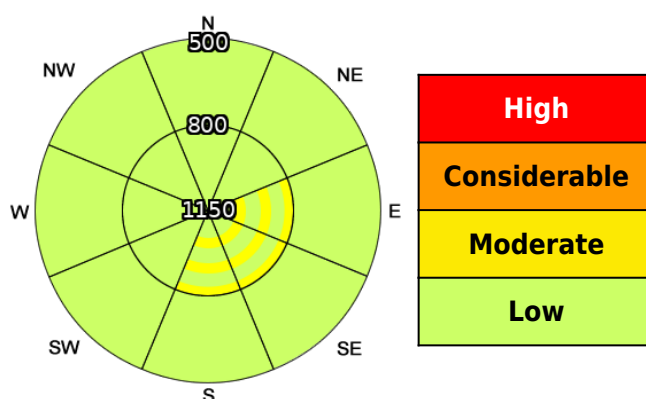


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/01/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally stable. At elevations above 1000 metres small areas of windslab may develop in sheltered locations on mainly East to Southerly aspects. During the day some softening of the snow surface will be evident below 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight the freezing level will be at 1000m with a trace of snow possible. Winds will be moderate West-North-Westerly strengthening in the day. Light sleet showers are expected and the freezing level will rise to summit levels.

**Comments**

At lower levels, today was the first day for many where crampons were not always required. Despite temperatures edging above zero on some summits good snow cover remains.
