

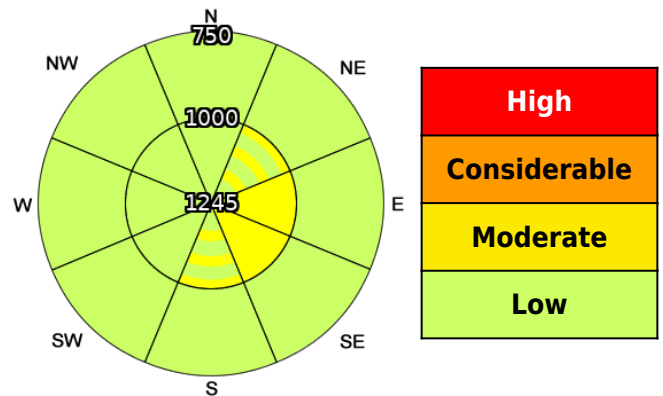

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately stable, small deposits of windslab will continue to form in isolated locations, especially in sheltered hollows and around corrie rims mainly above 1000 metres on East to Southerly aspects. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, light snow showers will continue with moderate North-Westerly winds, the snow showers will gradually die out in the day. The freezing level will be at summit levels.
