

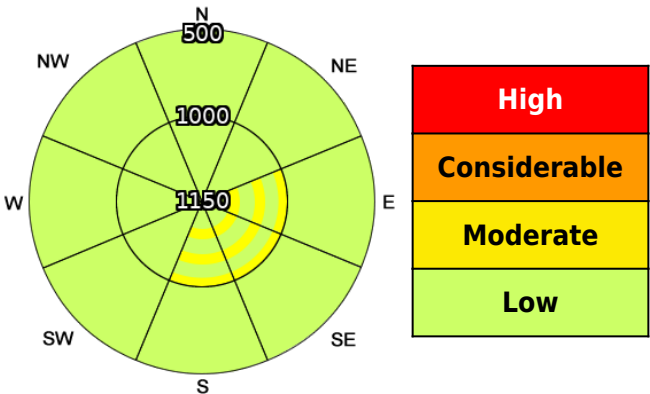

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The overnight snow showers will deposit small and isolated areas of windslab on East to South aspects above 1000 metres. On other aspects, and at lower altitudes, the snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and stability will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional showers will fall as snow above around 1000 metres during the early part of the night. It will remain dry for the rest of the forecast period. Moderate winds will be from the North-West.

Comments

No major weather events on the horizon - normal avalanche precautions advised.
