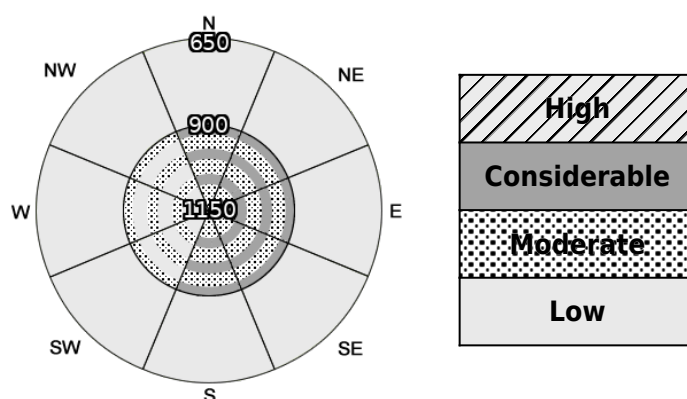

Unstable windslab will form in sheltered areas such as summit gullies and on slopes with an East to Southerly aspect mainly above 900 metres. Steeper scarp slope and gully exits will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be a period of heavier snow early on Monday evening. This will be followed by light snow at times overnight and on Tuesday. Winds will be fresh to strong from the North West
