



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 26/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will refreeze at all levels and on all aspects and will generally be well bonded and stable. Initially new snow accumulations that form on mainly East to Southerly aspects will bond well, however instabilities will develop as windslab amounts increase mainly above 900 metres on steep sheltered areas and hollows on South-East to South-West facing slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will fall to 600 metres and will remain at this level during the day. Light snow is expected throughout the forecast period. Winds will be very strong North-Westerly overnight and strong Northerly in the day.
