

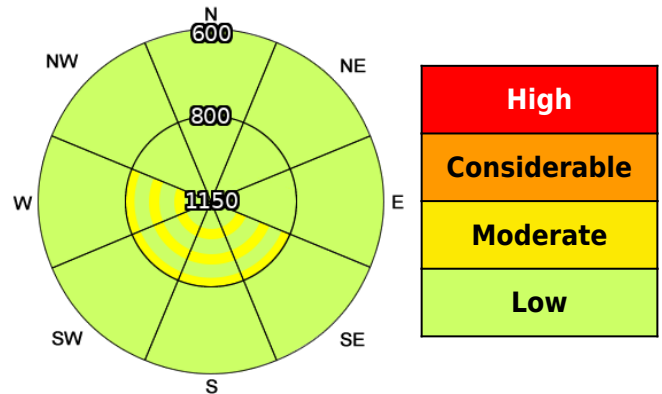

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 26/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will further consolidate in the colder temperatures. It will be hard, icy and very stable. Small and generally avoidable areas of fresh windslab will be deposited on South-East through South to West aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be colder than of late with a freezing level of around 600 metres. There will be a few snow showers overnight and through the day. Strong Northerly winds will veer to the North-East.
