

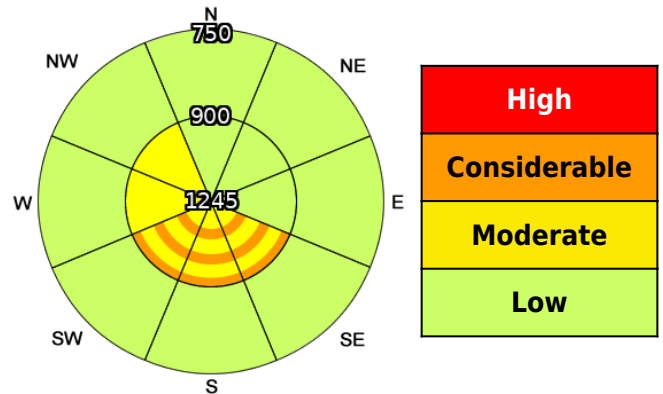

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable accumulations of windslab, largely localised, will be present on mainly South-East to South-Westerly aspects above 900 metres, although patches of windslab will be present in hollows on many aspects. Steeper sheltered areas such as, corrie rims and gully flanks will be most affected. Elsewhere the snow pack will be refrozen, well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the winds will be moderate to light Easterly, snow showers in the night will die out. The freezing level will be at 600 metres.
