

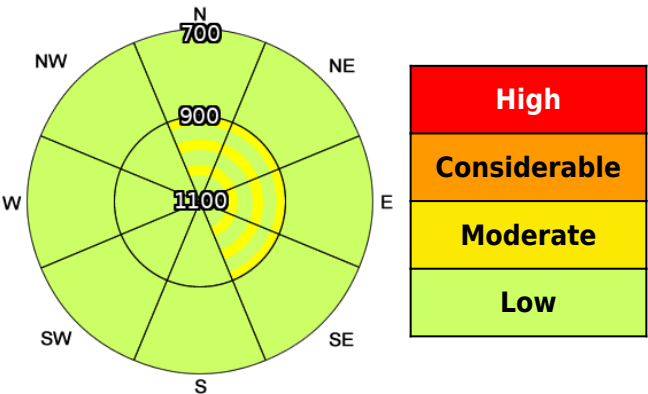

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 29/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well-stabilised in most locations. Accumulations of less well-bonded snow may form on steep, sheltered North through East to South-East gully tops and corrie headwalls above 900m, although this is not expected to be extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow showers are possible overnight. Winds will be moderate South-Westerly, later Northerly during the day.

Comments

Overcast and misty near summits on Friday. Outlook is for settled weather.
