

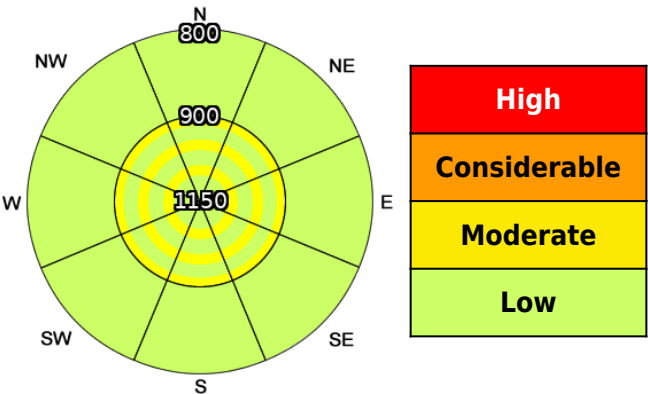

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 29/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In most places snowpack stability will remain good with a widespread firm and icy surface. Light snow showers and variable winds will form isolated areas of windslab in sheltered locations. Sheltered summit gully exits, corniced areas and steep scarp slopes will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a few light snow showers overnight becoming dry in the day. Winds will be fresh South-Westerly becoming Northerly by morning. The freezing level will be 900 metres.

Comments

Snowpack should remain firm and icy on many slopes some of which have serious run outs onto rocks. New snow amounts are not expected to be great.
