

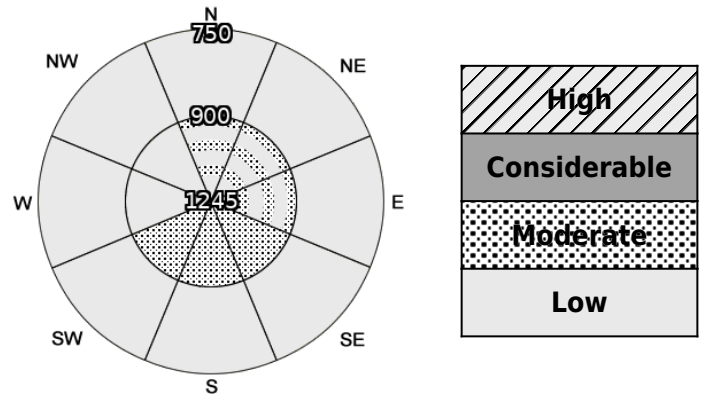

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 29/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New localised accumulations of windslab will develop on North to East aspects and moderately bonded windslab will remain on South-East to South-West facing slopes. On these aspects above 900 metres instabilities will affect areas of steep terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, a few light snow showers are expected on light to moderate South-West winds. During the day it will be dry and moderate winds will veer to the North. The freezing level will be at 910 metres.

Comments

Underfoot conditions good for walking and ski touring. Serious run out potential on steep slopes.
