



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow showers will deposit areas of windslab on North to East aspects above 900 metres. This strong winds will also re-deposit any existing soft surface deposits onto these locations. The new deposits of windslab are not expected to be extensive. Elsewhere the snowpack will be firm and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night and morning, some light snow is expected during the afternoon. Moderate Southerly winds will veer to the South-West and strengthen. The freezing level will be around 900 metres.

Comments

Winds expected to increase in strength over the next few days.
