



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 31/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab will affect sheltered locations such as Coire rims and gully tops particularly on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 950 metres. This windslab will further weaken as the temperature rises leading to instabilities particularly in areas of steep terrain where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight there will be occasional light snow showers at the highest elevations, this will turn to light rain during the day as the freezing level rises to 2000 metres. The winds will be South-Westerlies, strong increasing to gale force.
