

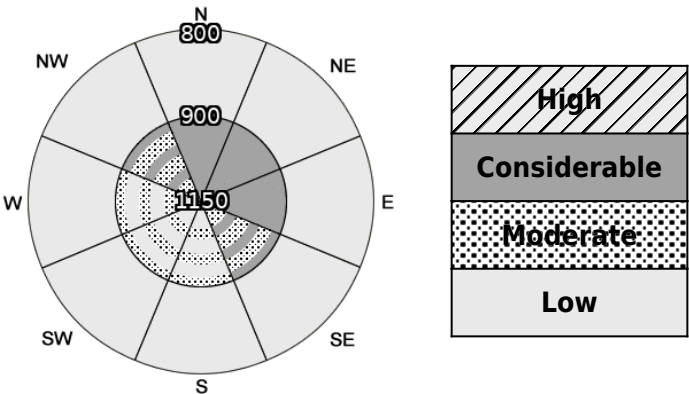
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 31/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will exist in sheltered summit gullies and on slopes with a North-West through North to South-Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation will fall as sleet and snow overnight turning to heavy rain at all levels on Monday as the freezing level rises to 2000 metres. Winds will be strong to gale force from the South-West.

Comments

Mild windy and wet outlook. Hazard of falling rock and ice.
