

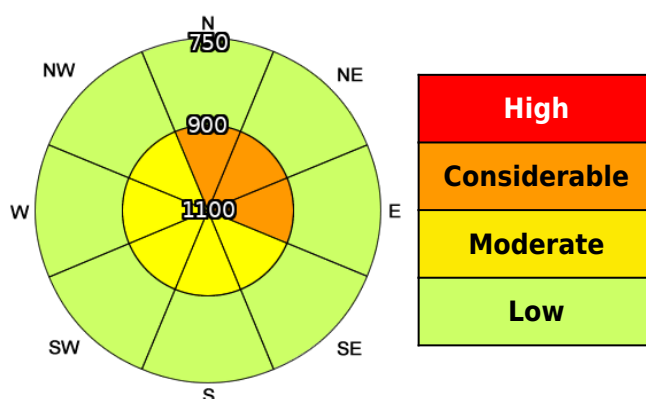

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 31/01/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of poor stability on North to East aspects above 900 metres with the onset of much milder temperatures and when snow turns to rain. The surface layers of the snowpack in most other locations will become moist but remain reasonably well-bonded. Cornices may soften and become weaker in wet and heavy thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall will continue overnight then give way to heavy rain and much milder temperatures with the freezing level rising to well above summits. Winds will be strong South-Westerly.
