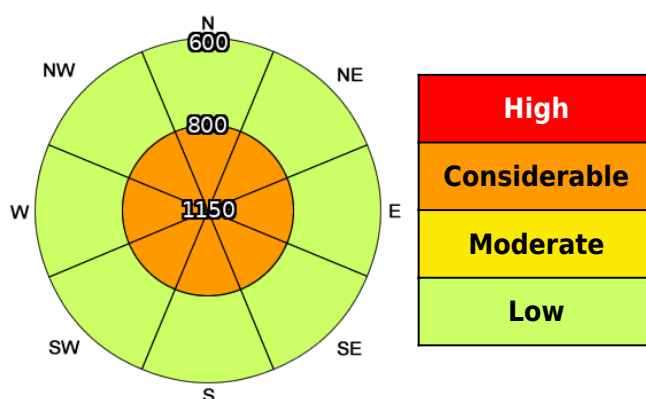


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 31/01/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The onset of rain up to high elevations will contribute to a period of instability. Avalanches are likely on all aspects above 800 metres where there will be new snow instability and due to the weakening effect on the faceted snow bridged with crust. Steep convex terrain, exit slopes of gullies and climbs will be effected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Rain is forecast at all elevations with strong South-Westerly winds.

The period soon after the onset of rain is usually the time of poorest stability.
